The proposed amendments would increase the terms of office from two (2) years to four (4) years for the mayor and the four (4) city commissioners who are elected from zones.

**Shall Section 5.06 of the City Charter Be Amended?**

The proposed amendment would require candidates to run against each other in a "regular election" in October of each odd-numbered year; any candidate receiving more than 50% of votes in said election shall be declared the winner; where no candidate receives more than 50% of votes, a run-off election shall be held 28 days later; and the outcome of a tie vote in a run-off election shall be decided by lot.

The proposed amendments would require candidates for elected office to maintain permanent residence in the City for at least one year, and in the case of a city commissioner reside in the zone from which they are running at least thirty days immediately prior to the first day of qualification for office; and that elected city commissioners continue to permanently reside in the zone from which elected.
